

## HERITAGE TRAIL

### Hikers Information & Patch & Medal Application

Trail users who hike the Heritage Trail are eligible to purchase a unique six color patch and/or a medal through the Hancock Park District. A "Trail Questionnaire" is used for an individual or group to verify completing the entire 20 mile trail for ordering the patch/medal.

#### Guidelines:

1. The application for patches must be filed in the same calendar year as the Trail is completed.
2. The group leader certifies that the Trail has been completed by those receiving patches/medals. Limit of one patch/medal per individual.
3. A complete Trail questionnaire (below) is returned with each order.
4. Use one application for each different completion date and group.
5. Send/bring completed "Trail Patch Application" form to the Hancock Park District, 1424 East Main Cross, Findlay, OH 45840. Call 419-425-7275 for any additional information required.
