To Downtown Findlay

Bikepath

Ride a 10' paved bikeway 1.5 miles from Broad Avenue to Main Street, with connectors to River Landings and Swale Park. The Howard Run crossing features the Brugeman Bridge, views of the Blanchard River, and wooded sections through parks, alive with watchable wildlife.

Handlebar Hollow

Kids of all ages can take the two-mile, one-way loop challenge on a narrow winding, mountain bike trail through rugged terrain. Developed by the Hancock Handlebars Bicycle Club and local volunteers, the cross-country trail has natural hazards, hills, switchbacks, and obstacles. Enter the loop at the River Landings trailhead or near High Street on the bike path.

Heritage Trail

The urban trail section of the nationally recognized 20-mile Boy Scout trail developed in the 1960's follows the bike path along the Greenway at this point. Maps of the whole trail are available at the Park District office and hiking patches and medals can also be obtained for hiking the entire length.

BMX Course

A one-half acre course over moguls and mounds give non-motorized dirt bikes a challenge for the younger ages. Area bicyclists are developing the course that is expected to change regularly in cooperation with the Findlay Parks & Recreation Department. Only BMX bikes admitted for safety.

Trail Tips

- ❖ Ride, roller blade, skateboard, or jog with respect for other users.
- ❖ Caution: strollers, scooters, wheelchairs also on trail.
- ❖ No motorized vehicles
- ❖ Pick up, pack out items brought to Greenway. No littering.
- ❖ All Hancock Park District Rules & Regulations apply as posted at River Landings.
- ❖ Stay on path for appropriate direction.
- ❖ Yield to traffic and bicycles at crossings. Pass on left.
