Park Laborer

JOB DESCRIPTION

The park laborer works outside in the Hancock Park System, exercises by performing a variety of physical work, and serves the community by providing customer service in the form of park maintenance. The park laborer will work with a full-time park manager to maintain parks and facilities, protect the natural environment and its wildlife, promote facility readiness, complete park improvement projects, serve park visitors, and perform tasks in support of programs, activities, and special events.

The park laborer can expect to mow and trim grass, pull weeds, water trees, pick up litter, remove debris from parking lots, trails, and walkways (all hard surfaces), remove trash and recyclable material and dispose of it properly, paint, make repairs, clean restroom facilities and site amenities, conduct inspections, and implement Park Maintenance Standards.

The Hancock Park District is in the service industry. This is an opportunity for a service-minded individual and hard worker to earn money, serve the community, and spend time outdoors.

QUALIFICATIONS

The minimum education requirements necessary to perform the essential duties of this position are typically acquired through high school level coursework plus experience performing grounds maintenance or at least have an interest in learning about and performing park maintenance. The park laborer is expected to communicate in a clear and professional manner both orally and in writing and maintain a positive attitude toward co-workers, supervisors, and customers. Applicants who can commit to a 12-week employment period starting in late May or early June are preferred. Per the Fair Labor Standards Act, park laborers must be at least 16 years of age.

PAY RATE AND BENEFITS

The pay rate is \$15.08 an hour. Park laborers can work up to 480 hours (40 hours a week x 12 weeks). Benefits include a pension plan through the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS).
