Park Maintenance Technician

JOB DESCRIPTION

The park maintenance technician is responsible for handling special projects and repairs; maintaining parks, trails, facilities, buildings, vehicles, and equipment; supporting programs, special events, and services; and implementing the overarching park maintenance standards (safety, cleanliness, function, aesthetics, and customer service).

QUALIFICATIONS

The Hancock Park District Park Maintenance Technician should have a Bachelor of Science degree in Park Management, Natural Resources, Environmental Science, or a closely related field plus at least two years of relevant experience with park management and hands-on maintenance of parks, trails, facilities, buildings, vehicles, and equipment, and have basic construction and electrical knowledge or have any combination of education and experience that demonstrates the ability to handle the responsibilities and essential duties of the position. The park maintenance technician should communicate in a clear and professional manner both orally and in writing, demonstrate high professional standards and a progressive park management mindset, and be willing to accept new challenges, technologies, and opportunities.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

The starting pay rate for this position is \$19.60 an hour up to a maximum of 1,200 hours each year. Classification: Grade 6 – Permanent/Part-time. Benefits include one paid personal day each year and a pension plan through the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS).
